The scholarship will be presented at the annual Winter Conference in January. A report from the recipient may be required at the end of the semester.

Scholarship Amount

The total scholarship amount allotted for 2020 is \$5,000 to be divided among one or more students and is for:

Undergraduate students enrolled in 12 or more hours;

Graduate students enrolled in 6 or more hours if working full time, or 9 hours if not working full time.
